

Japan

Japan is an island country located in East Asia, in the Pacific Ocean, and consists of over 6,800 islands, with the four main ones being Honshu, Hokkaido, Kyushu, and Shikoku. Its capital city is Tokyo, one of the largest and most populated cities in the world. About 70% of Japan's land is mountainous, and the country is known for natural features such as Mount Fuji, volcanoes, and frequent earthquakes. Japan is famous for successfully combining ancient traditions—like Shinto shrines, Buddhist temples, tea ceremonies, and traditional festivals—with modern life and advanced technology. The culture strongly emphasizes respect, discipline, and harmony, which can be seen in daily life, education, and work. Japan is also globally known for its cuisine, including sushi, ramen, and tempura, as well as for its contributions to technology, transportation, and popular culture such as anime and video games.

Clothes:

Traditional Japanese clothing, known as wafuku, is typically worn for ceremonies and special events, with some items like the yukata being popular for summer festivals.

Kimono: The most iconic garment, it is a full-length, T-shaped robe wrapped around the body (left side over right) and secured with a wide belt called an obi. Formal kimonos are often made of silk and worn with accessories like zōri sandals and tabi socks.



Yukata: A more casual and lightweight cotton version of the kimono, typically worn during the warmer months, after bathing at a traditional inn (ryokan), or to summer festivals.



Haori: A short, open-front jacket worn over a kimono or yukata, the haori has been adapted into modern fashion for layering over contemporary outfits.



Hakama: A long, wide, pleated skirt-like or divided trouser worn over a kimono. Traditionally worn by men of various occupations, it is now often worn by women for graduation ceremonies or martial arts.

Jinbei: A matching top and pants set made of natural materials like cotton or hemp, most often worn as comfortable loungewear or by men and boys to summer festivals.

Japanese food is known for being healthy, balanced, and tasty. Most meals include rice, vegetables, and fish or meat. Japanese cooking focuses on fresh ingredients and simple flavors.
