

- Students created pages for 9 netiquette rules, voted for the best ones and then created their own relevant e-book, in Greek and english!






Introducing ourselves and our neighborhoods using web 2.0 tools in a creative and collaborative way








THE PALATINE CHAPEL


Online meetings with our partners from Sicily -Italy, Mallorca - Spain and Azores – Portugal were the best (December, March, May)!









Project evaluation


We loved it!
