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TEACHERS

- STRESS


THAT IN CRITICAL SITUATIONS COULD END INTO SUICIDE



TEACHERS-UNDERPAYMENT

IT COST ROUGHLY \$740 BILLION TO EDUCATE AMERICA'S 50 MILLION PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS LAST YEAR, THE NATIONAL CENTER FOR EDUCATION STATISTICS HAS FOUND, INCLUDING SOME \$260 BILLION FOR TEACHER SALARIES (THE AVERAGE TEACHER SALARY WAS \$62,760 IN 2018). STATES AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS PUT ANOTHER \$60 BILLION IN TEACHER PENSION PLANS, ON TOP OF TEACHERS' OWN CONTRIBUTIONS, ACCORDING TO BOSTON COLLEGE'S PUBLIC PLANS DATABASE. THE PROBLEM IS THAT ONLY ABOUT 30 PERCENT OF STATE AND DISTRICT RETIREMENT CONTRIBUTIONS PAY THE PREDICTED COST OF SUPPORTING RETIRED TEACHERS. THE OTHER 70 PERCENT—\$42 BILLION DOLLARS A YEAR—IS SPENT BACKFILLING MASSIVE SHORTFALLS IN THE FUNDS NEEDED TO PAY ALL FUTURE PROMISED PENSION BENEFITS.

AS YOU CAN GUESS, TEACHERS THROUGH THE WORLD ARE EXPERIENCING FINANCIAL PROBLEMS. AMERICA, THE EXAMPLE THAT I USED, IS ROUGHLY MANAGING TO KEEP EVERYTHING ALL RIGHT FOR THE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM.



TEACHERS-INTERNET CLASSES

TEACHERS ALSO HAVE TO PHASE THE INTERNET CLASS PROBLEMS (THE SO CALLED E CLASS). MAKES THEM VERY ANGRY AND SAD.

STUDENTS-BLUE SCREEN

• FURTHERMORE, INTERNET CLASSES ARE ALSO QUITE THE PROBLEM AS THEY REQUIRE STUDENT TO STAY HOURS IN FRONT OF COMPUTER. TO MUCH EXPOSURE TO BLUE SCREENS MAY DAMAGE THE STUDENT PHYSICALLY, FOR EXAMPLE, PAIN ON THE NECK AND SHOULDERS, HEADACHES AND EYESTRAIN (NOT ALL INCLUDED)

STUDENTS-INTERNET CLASS

• WE MUST RECOGNIZE EDUCATING STUDENTS FROM COMPUTERS ISN'T SO EFFECTIVE. AS A MATTER OF FACT THAT MOST STUDENT ARE DISORGANIZED .IN ADDITION, TEACHERS SOMETIMES CANNOT APPROACH A STIMULATING LESSON, WHICH IS ABLE TO ATTRACT THE STUDENTS ATTENTION . ONLINE LESSONS MAY EXPERIENCE TECHNOLOGICAL, LIKE LOSE OF SOUND OR BAD CONNECTION . EDUCATION-PSYCHOLOGICAL FACTOR

AFTER ONE YEAR OF COVID-19 BEING AROUND AND STUDENTS HAVING TO DO ONLINE LESSONS IT HAS COME TO NOTICE HOW IT HAS NEGATIVELY AFFECTED EVERYONE.

• FIRSTLY, ONE WAY THE STUDENTS AND TEACHERS HAVE BEEN AFFECTED BY THIS IS BY THE HOURS THEY MUST SPEND LOOKING AT THEIR SCREENS AND RESULTING INTO HEALTH PROBLEMS (MENTIONED EARLIER) AND ANXIETY. 




