

The Arapis custom

According to the custom on Halloween, someone dressed up in a goat's costume. "Arapis" roamed the streets of the village accompanied by folk instruments, dancing and making various jokes and pranks. Also on the Sunday of Carnival in the village square it is customary to burn the Carnival, which is an effigy filled with straw. It is a custom whose origin is obviously very old and has similarities with the worship of Dionysus, the God of wine, the ancient Greeks.
