- **The non-profit art gallery**. These galleries tend to prioritize their selection of artists based on accolades as opposed to word-of-mouth or popularity.

The primary purpose of an art gallery is to nurture visual artists, promote their work, and expose them to the public, collectors, media, and cultural institutions. Furthermore, the gallery works tirelessly and strategically to advance the artists' careers and establish them in the professional art world both locally and globally. To achieve this vast mission, a gallery must provide <u>appropriate exhibition space</u>, manage administrative and curatorial staff, provide insurance, secure advertising, invest and participate in a myriad of very expensive art fairs, develop and set up websites, pay for subscriptions, and produce timely and well-attended events. Each gallery (that was also mentioned above) represents and promotes a group of artists that, in general terms, follows a specific line and style; this makes each art gallery unique.

Art galleries exhibit works by artists known by the general public, drive the career of young contemporary artists or recover the name of those artist whom, despite the quality of their work, for historical reasons have been relegated to the background. Sometimes, the work of recuperating an artist or an artistic movement can be at the same level as the work of a museum, therefore, in several occasions the function of the gallery is not exclusively commercial.
