care and harmony.



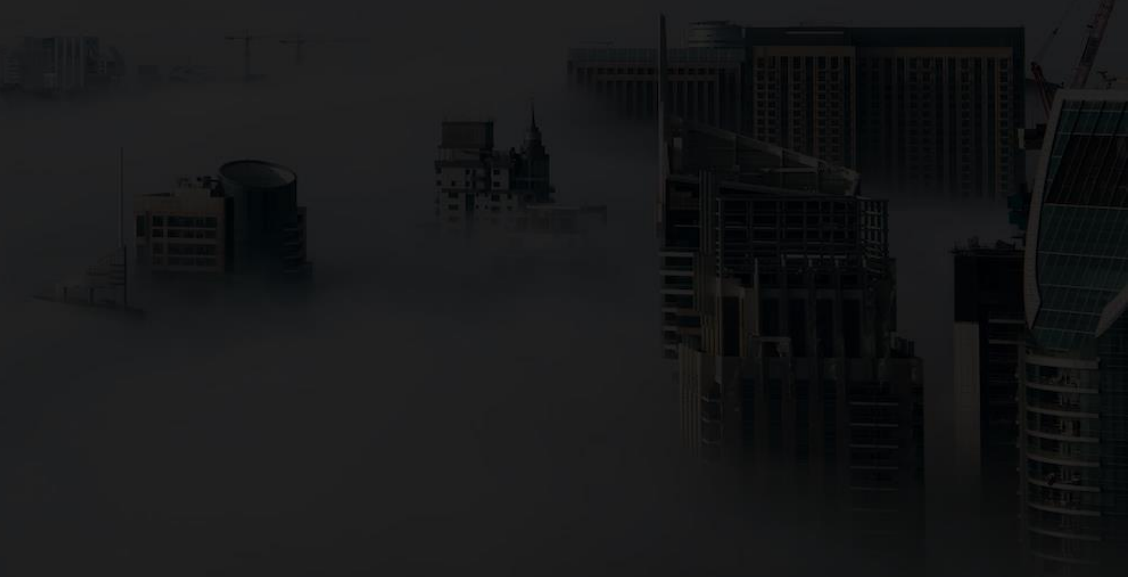
21st century

- **Education**

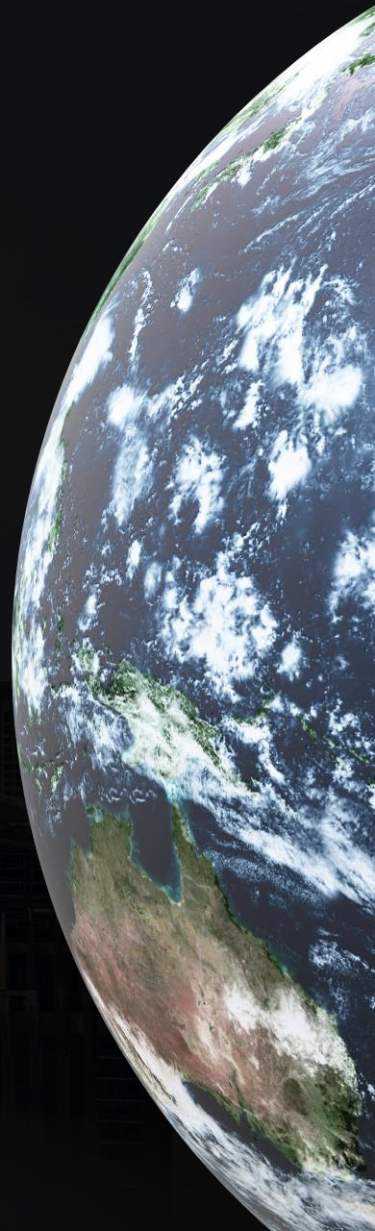
